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Goal & Methods


- Gather information to inform key healthcare stakeholders about telemedicine & telehealth use & needs in our state
- Developed survey & piloted with select set organizations to get feedback & validate
- Distributed to Northern AZ sites Spring 2019
- Followed up with in-depth phone surveys
- Distributed across Northern & Southern AZ
- Copy of survey on your thumb drive






80 unique survey responses

 some organizations have multiple sites




Type Institution







- 59% (n = 47) provide TH services
- 25% (n = 20) receive TH services



Total est # cases 2017-2018: 113,876 Mean = 2920(SD = 6227, range = 10 - 27,000)

For those outsourcing: Mean # outsourced organizations = 2.93 (sd = 1.19; range = 1 - 10)











Reimbursement

- Is your organization ever reimbursed a different amount for the same service provided via telemedicine vs. in person? 62% (n = 26) = yes
- When you bill for services, approximately what percentage, overall, of your organization's telemedicine services get reimbursed by payers (excluding teleradiology)? Mean = 63% (sd = 45, range = 0-175)
- On average (across all payers), approximately what percentage of the overall in-person reimbursement rate does your organization receive for the same services provided via telemedicine (excluding teleradiology)?


Mean = 71% (sd = 44, range = 0-180)






Stopped Providing TH Services

Interview Themes

- Everyone (doing & not) see benefits TH & plan to engage/extend
- Drivers: service needs, staffing, pt demand, prov demand
- Challenges: logistics, personnel, platform choices, \$\$,
 reimbursement concerns, legal/liability concerns, time, lic/cred
 hassles, turnover & training, EHR integration

- Hundreds of thousands of pts benefitted past 20+ years
- More sites providing, receiving & planning TH
