Ronald S. Weinstein, MD, Unveils Flexner 3.0 Medical Science Curriculum at Johns Hopkins School of Medicine

"Flexner 3.0," Dr. Weinstein's latest invention, recalibrates health science education for the United States by repositioning "introduction to medical science coursework" from medical schools into K-12 schools. His Flexner 3.0 program also calls for reducing high school education by two years, and college and medical schools' by one year each. Dr. Weinstein states, "It was an honor to be invited to introduce the Flexner 3.0 curricular model at Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, the institution that pioneered our current standard model for medical education. 





