## **COVID Funding**

- COVID PHE led to massive interest in & uptake of TM by healthcare systems, clinics, private practice, DTC - everyone
- CMS & other federal/state agencies waived many prior restrictions
- Federal & state funds dedicated to enabling TM & infrastructure
- FY 2020 Cares Act funded TRCs to help in response to COVID PHE
- Each received 1-year grant \$828,571 Apr 2020 Mar 2021
- Legacy grant ongoing with RFP coming early 2021 for next round


















## <u>Summary</u>
