


### Eko Eko Academy







HELPING HOUSEHOLDS CONNECT DURING THE PANDEMIC

#### What is it?

#### A temporary FCC program to help households struggling to afford internet service during the pandemic.

#### The benefit provides:

- Up to \$50/month discount for broadband service;
  Up to \$75/month discount for households on qualifying
- Up to \$75/month discount for households on qualifying
  Tribal lands; and
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating
- provider.

#### Who is eligible?

#### A household is eligible if one member of the household:

- Has an income that is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participates in certain government assistance programs;
   Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch or breakfast program;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
  Experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.





### Apply Now! Discounts on Internet Service and Computers



The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) is a temporary discount on monthly internet bills for qualifying low-income households.

- Up to \$50 per month for broadband services purchased by eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households located on Tribal lands.
- A one-time discount of \$100 for purchase of a desktop, laptop or tablet computer from participating providers.

Applications are now available. Only one monthly service discount and one device discount is allowed per household.














ATP and SWTRC offer one-day **Telemedicine Training** courses. There are two tracks offered throughout the year:








TELEMEDICINE TRAINING Our telemedicine training not only has a great reach across Arizona, we have a national reach and an international reach.

- In 2021, telemedicine trainings reached 11 of the 15 Arizona counties.
- From 2010-2020, our telemedicine training session have reached 1178 participants across the nation, plus six other countries.
- Participants included:
  - 17% MD/NMD/DO
  - 15% RN/NP/LPN
  - 11% C-suite
  - 4% healthcare students.




