



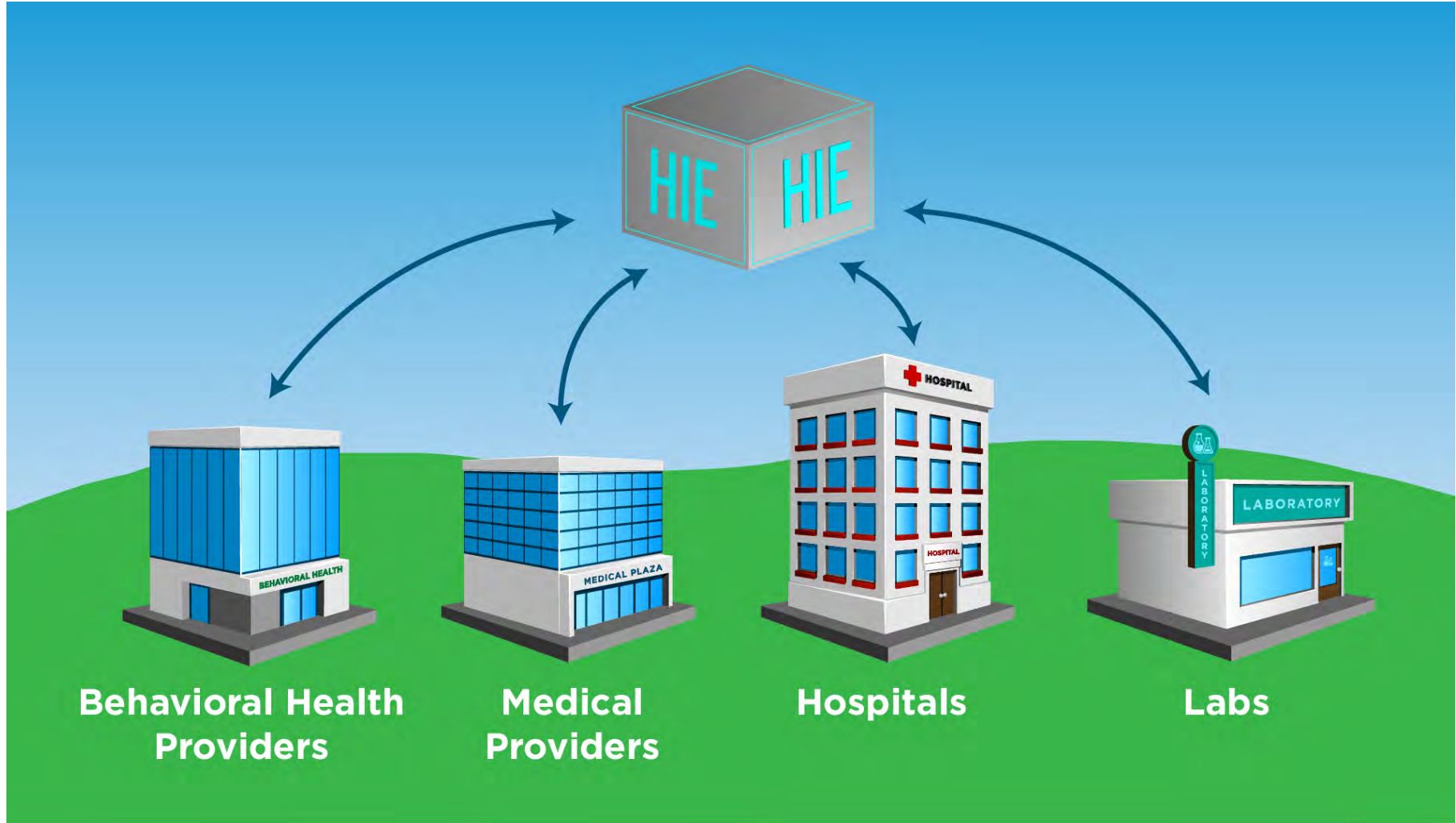

- Interoperability will be shaped by upcoming federal regulations, further advancing data sharing and patient access

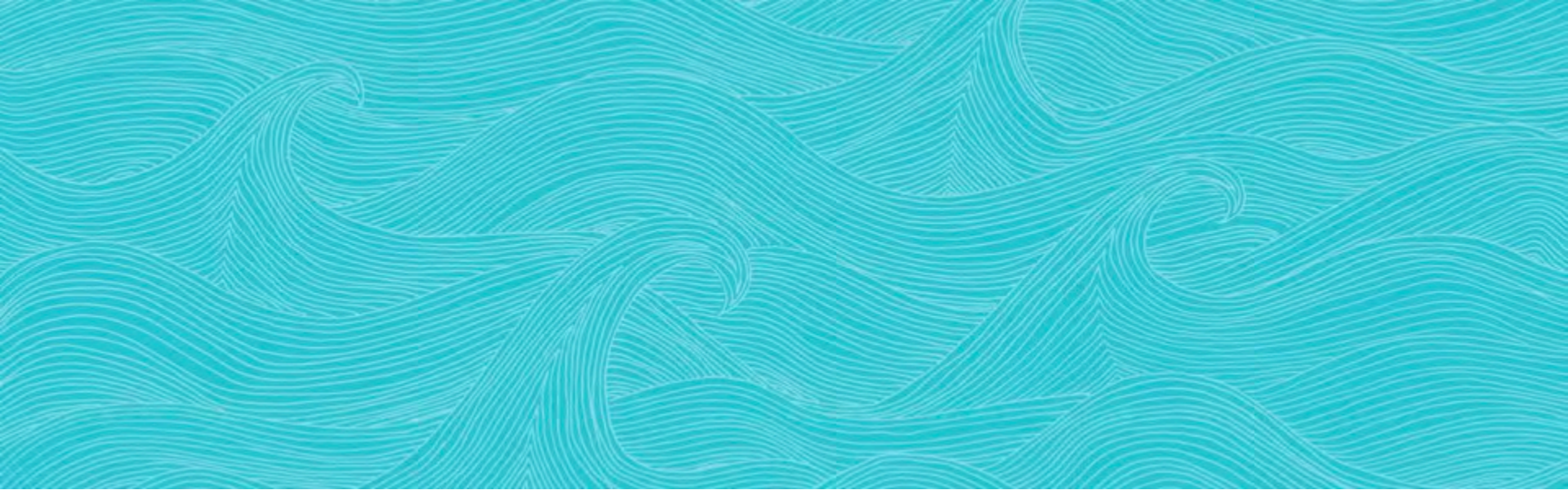


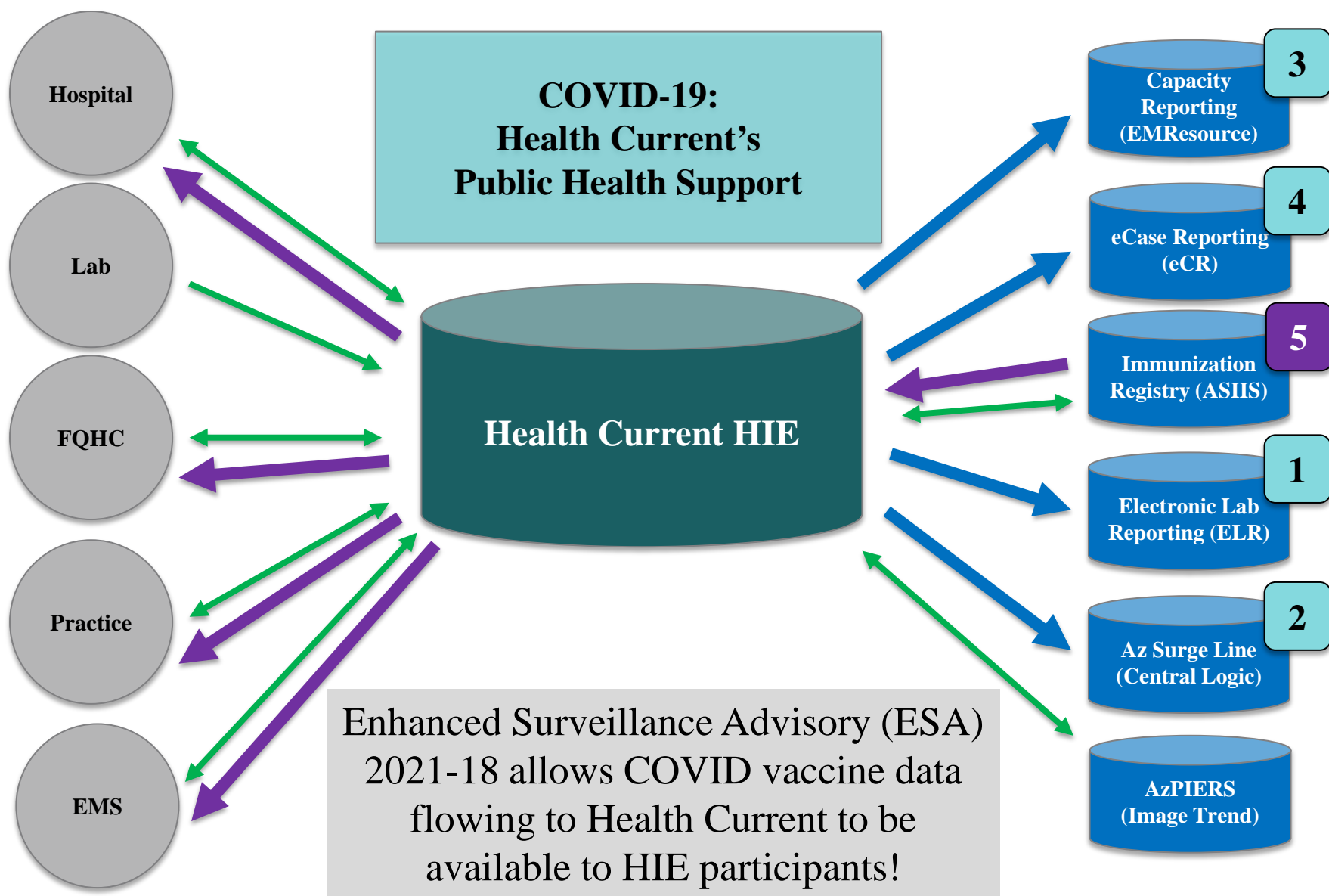

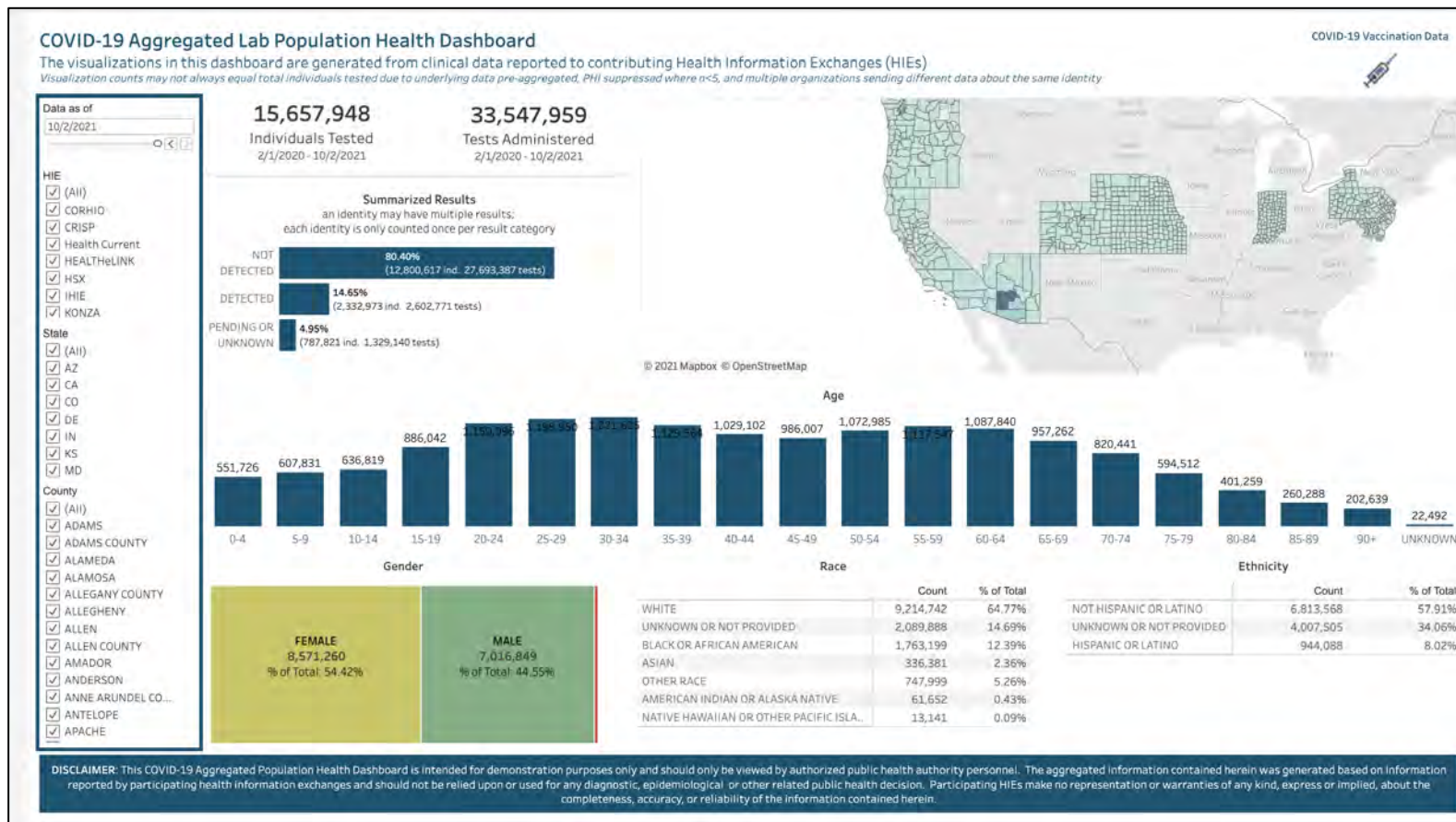

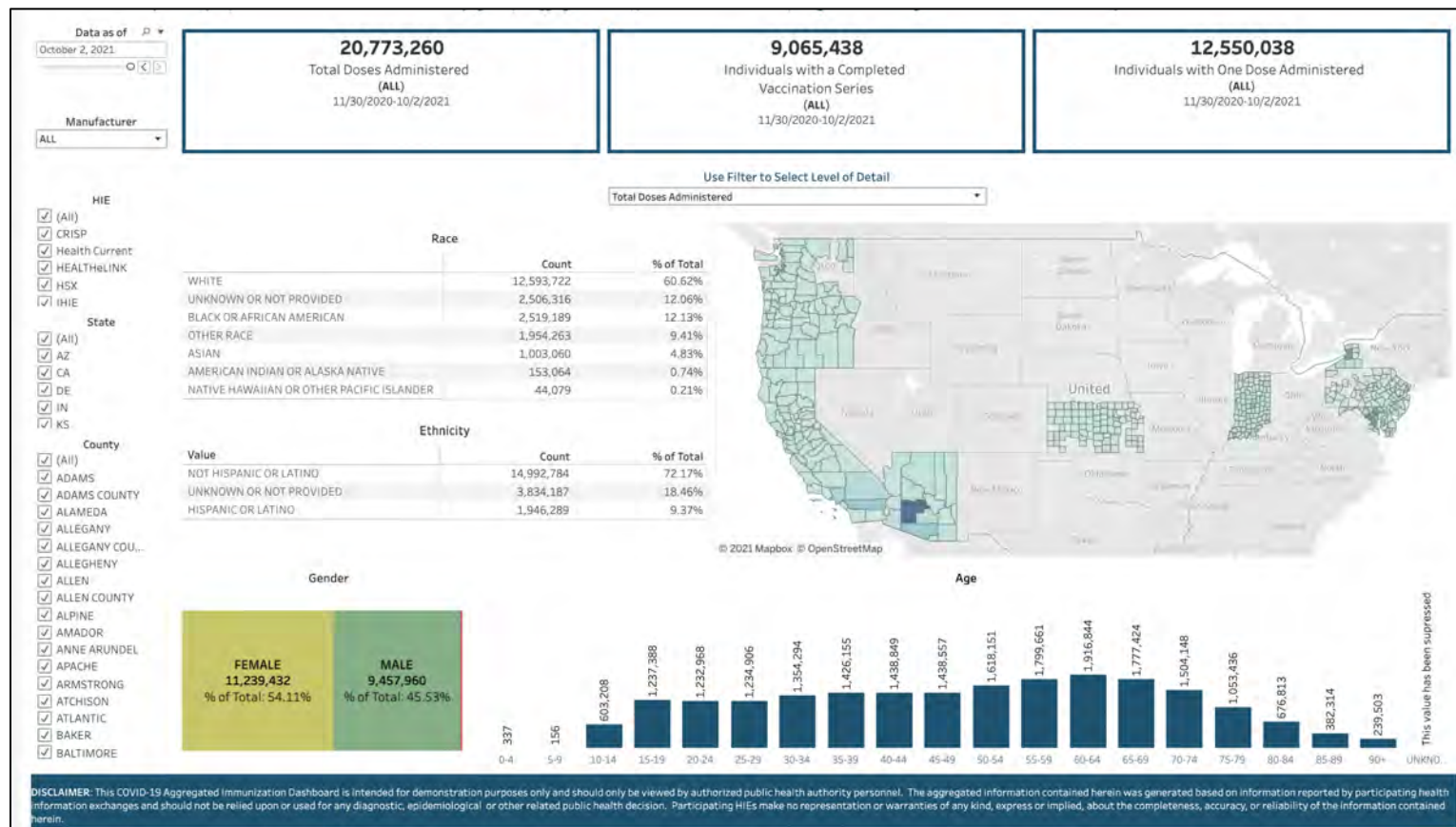

Communicable Disease Surveillance & Reporting

Overview

Health Current is pleased to introduce Communicable Disease Surveillance & Reporting (CDSR), a new service designed to submit case reports from hospitals to the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS), by developing a standardized approach to use Health Current's statewide health information exchange (HIE) as an intermediary between Arizona hospitals and ADHS. CDSR will support ADHS by improving the timeliness, accuracy, and completeness of communicable disease reporting, especially during emergencies such as a pandemic and will reduce hospital and health system burden related to state reporting requirements.



Hospitals & FQHCs interested in implementing electronic case reporting (eCase Reporting or eCR) should contact your Health Current account manager to get CDSR services.

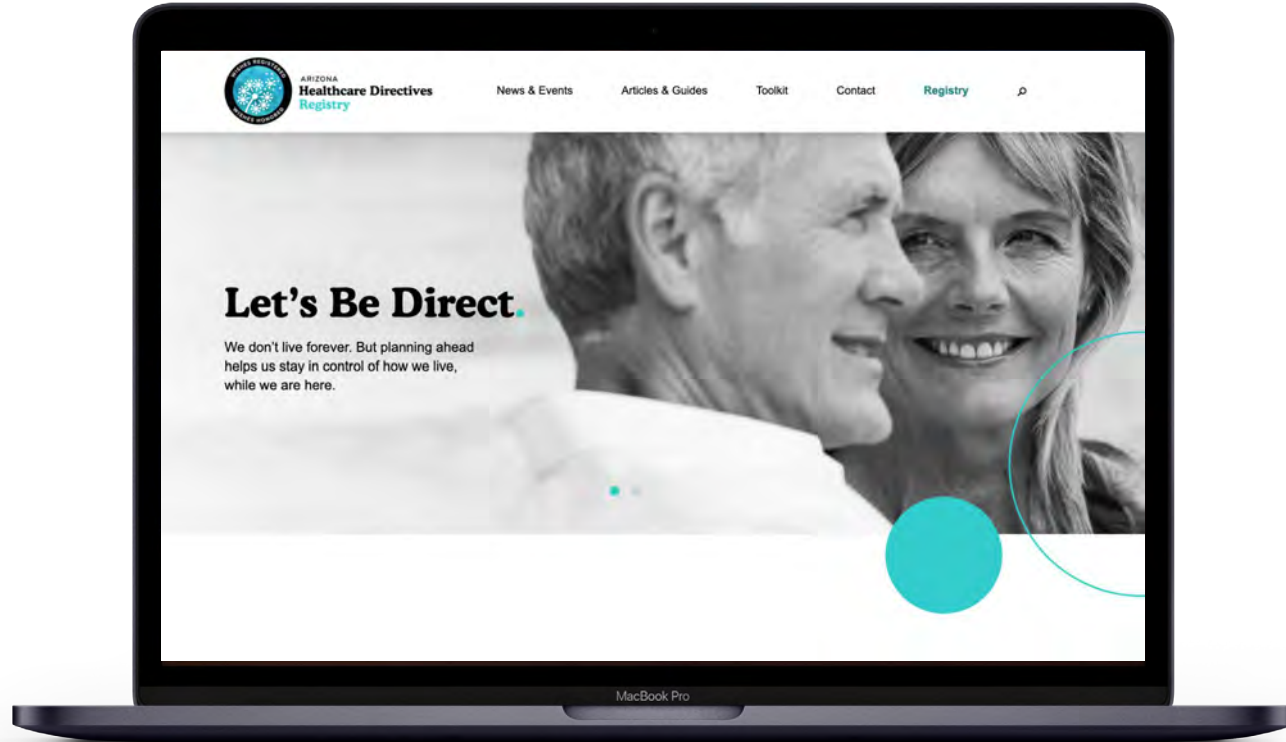


