Sodhi also spent her undergrad years gaining policy experience as a research fellow with the Arizona Telemedicine Program.

"I got to dig deep into telemedicine policy and merge the two interests," she says. "When I was deciding career tracks, it was between legislation in government or medicine. I chose medicine, but I still have a passion to work on policy."

Her work in telemedicine overlapped with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the pandemic, the potential of telemedicine was underappreciated, and Sodhi says they had to fight for attention.

"Then the pandemic hit. Telemedicine took off and everyone understood its power," she says. "All of a sudden, things that we'd been trying to get done for 20 years, the Legislature was like, 'Yep, approved.' That was the best part."
