## UA Nursing Professor Receives Telemedicine Grant to Study Tablet Use by Home Hospice Patients to Communicate with On-Call Nurses

Arizona Telemedicine Program Equipment Grant to provide technology for real-time visualization between the nurse and the patient and their caregiver.

It's the middle of the night. An elderly man in end-stage heart failure receiving at-home hospice awakes gasping for breath. His caregiver immediately phones the on-call nurse, but the drive could take her 30 minutes or more. The caregiver is too afraid to take action on her own, so she anxiously awaits the nurse. As the minutes tick by, the man becomes increasingly distressed and the caregiver grows more upset.

Shortness of breath (also known as dyspnea) is a common challenge faced by caregivers and patients in home hospice, and the leading cause of admissions to the emergency room for hospice patients.

Interested in shortening the time it takes to alleviate patient symptoms and caregiver anxiety, **Kimberly Shea, PhD, RN**, assistant professor at the [University of Arizona College of Nursing](#), conceived of using tablet technology with real-time visualization for patients and caregivers to communicate with on-call hospice nurses in urgent situations.

To support testing her idea, Dr. Shea recently was awarded a grant from the [Arizona Telemedicine Program](#) as part of its **Innovation Awards** for her project: "Real-Time Visualization for Reducing Symptom Severity in End-of-Life Care." The grant supports purchase of five iPad-minis with retina display.

"Previous studies evaluating tablet use in at-home hospice have been focused on overall quality of life and anxiety," said Dr. Shea, who has 15 years of experience as a home health/hospice nurse. "What makes my study different is I'm evaluating tablet use in urgent situations. Patient and/or caregiver anxiety can often lead to unnecessary emergency room admissions."

Each tablet will be equipped with real-time meeting software that allows the on-call nurse to immediately visualize important factors, such as a patient's positioning (lying down, sitting up) or breathing patterns and medications available. Accordingly, more individualized guidance can be given to the caregiver for intervening appropriately prior to nurse arrival.

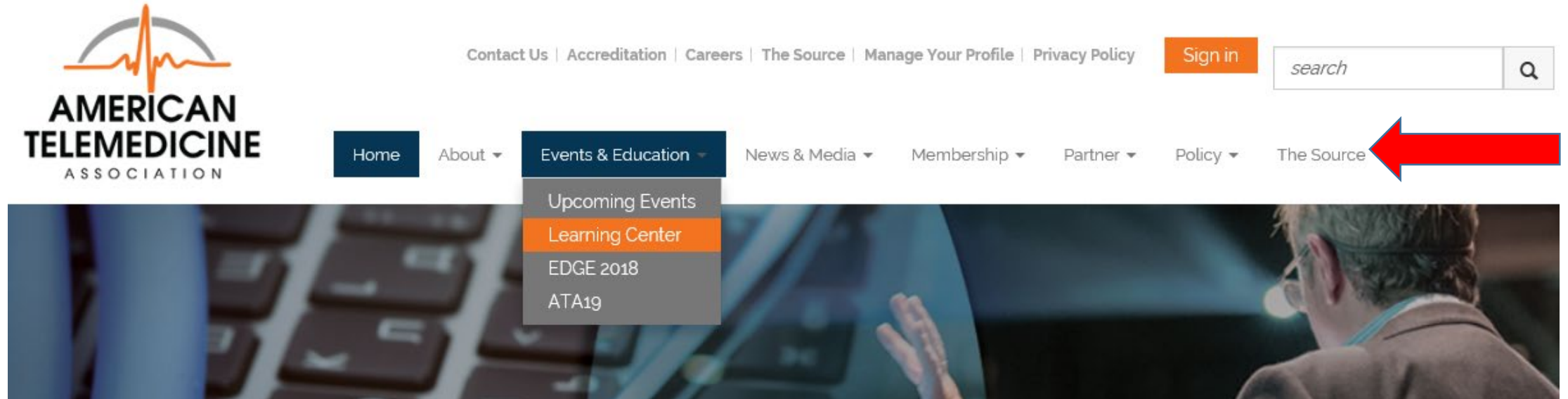
I am an assistant professor at the University of Arizona, College of Nursing, a full-time position that includes research in my chosen field of health care systems and informatics, in which I have a PhD.

## TELEHEALTH COVERAGE POLICIES IN THE TIME OF COVID-19 TO DATE

Timestamp: March 17, 2020 – 3 pm PT (UPDATES: Medicare, Other Federal Policies & State Actions)

As things rapidly develop regarding what we know about COVID-19, policies around telehealth have also been developing alongside of it. Below is a summary of what is covered by various public and private payers with the information that has been released. Keep in mind that events are evolving and to consider this a living document that could change frequently as new information and new policies become available/are enacted. CCHP will continue to make updates when they become available.

It was announced on March 17 that the telehealth waiver in Medicare under [HR 6074](#) has been implemented. Below is how the Medicare fee-for-service telehealth policies now stand.

MEDICARE FEE FOR SERVICE TELEHEALTH COVERAGE	
SUBJECT AREA	CURRENT POLICY UNDER COVID-19
Location of the Patient	Rural and site limitations are removed. Telehealth services can now be provided regardless of where the enrollee is located geographically and type of site, which allows the home to be an eligible originating site. However, locations that are newly eligible will <b>not</b> receive a facility fee.
Eligible Services	All services that are currently eligible under the Medicare telehealth reimbursement policies are included in this waiver. The list of eligible codes is available <a href="#">HERE</a> .
Eligible Providers	<p>The waiver did <b>not</b> expand the list of eligible providers to provide services and be reimbursed. The eligible providers are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Physicians</li><li>• Nurse practitioners</li><li>• Physician assistants</li><li>• Nurse-midwives</li><li>• Clinical nurse specialists</li><li>• Certified registered nurse anesthetists</li><li>• Clinical psychologists (CP)</li><li>• Clinical social workers (CSWs) (NOTE: CPs and CSWs cannot bill Medicare for psychiatric diagnostic interview examinations with medical services or medical evaluation and management services. They cannot bill or get paid for Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes 90792, 90833, 90836, and 90838).</li></ul>

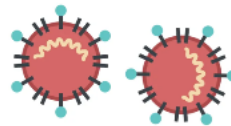

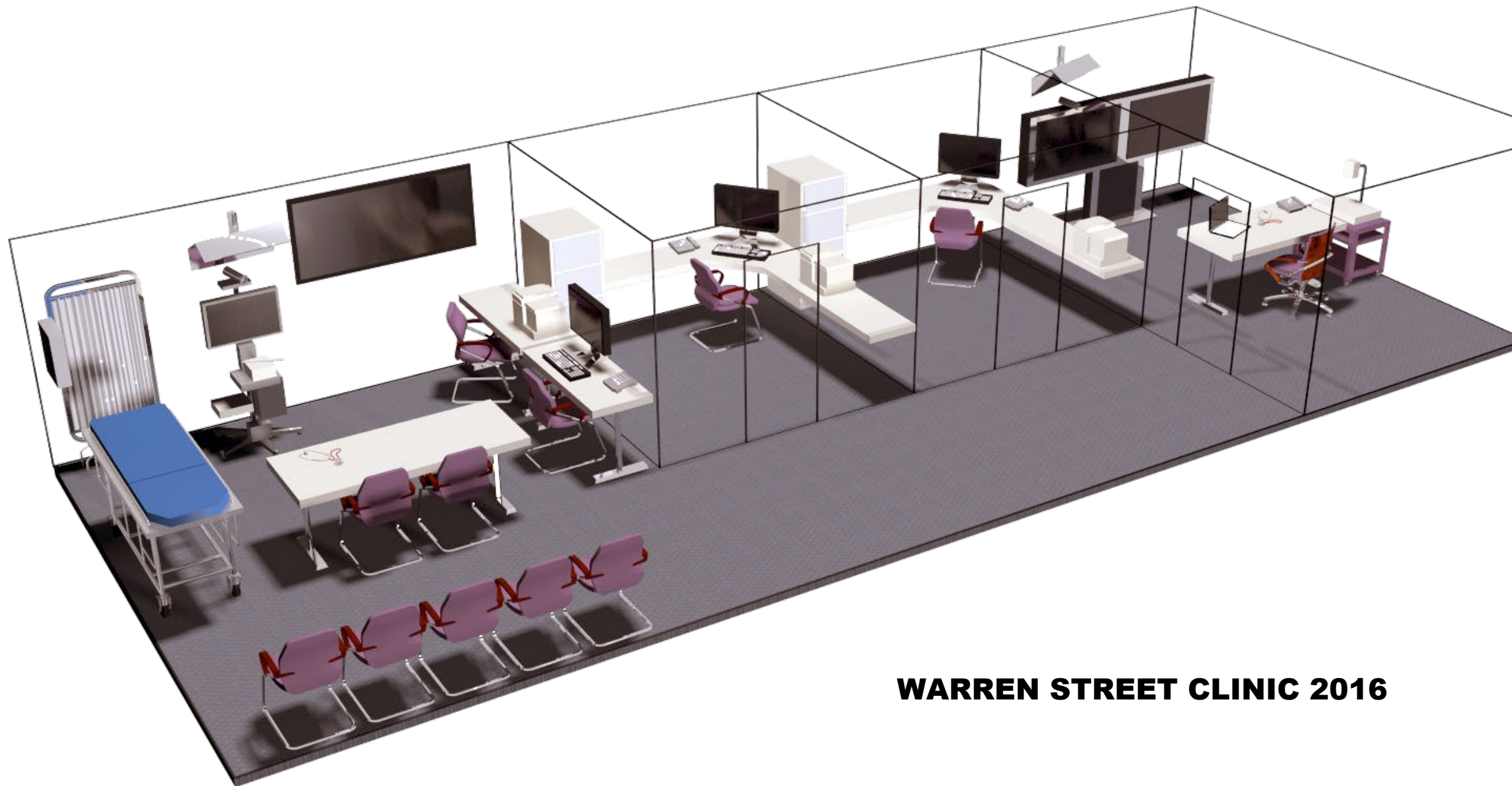

The Southwest Telehealth Resource Center (SWTRC) was established through a federal grant (#G221T16262) to advance telehealth services throughout the Southwest. It is one of the first telehealth centers in the United States, each serving a distinct geographic region. SWTRC serves hospitals, clinics, public health offices, and other providers in the broader Southwest region.

The SWTRC assists start-up telehealth programs and serves as a resource for existing programs regarding changes in technology and other issues affecting telehealth in the Southwest region.

Telemedicine has been shown empirically to improve access to quality medical care for many patients living in rural and medically underserved areas. The SWTRC draws expertise from the internationally recognized [Arizona Telemedicine Program](#), which has been providing telemedicine services throughout the state of Arizona since 1996.

The need for genetic counselors is immense as there simply are not enough to cover the number of patients requiring their services.

Sound familiar? Can you think of a solution? Telegenetics of course!

But as we all know, you can't just jump into telemedicine without some degree of training. That's where the [Western States Genetic Services Collaborative](#) (WSGSC) comes into play.

WSGSC is a HRSA-funded, multi-state project seeking to improve genetics and newborn screening services through sharing of resources across the region. The WSGSC includes Alaska, California, Guam, Hawaii, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington.

The Telegenetics Education and Training Program is a joint effort organized by the WSGSC and the Heartland Regional Genetics and Newborn Screening Collaborative. Working collaboratively with the Southwest Telehealth Resource Center (SWTRC) in Tucson, Arizona, and the South Central Telehealth Resource Center (SCTRC) in Little Rock, Arkansas, the Program seeks to train genetics providers, including genetic counselors and medical geneticists in the use of telehealth in clinical genetics practice.

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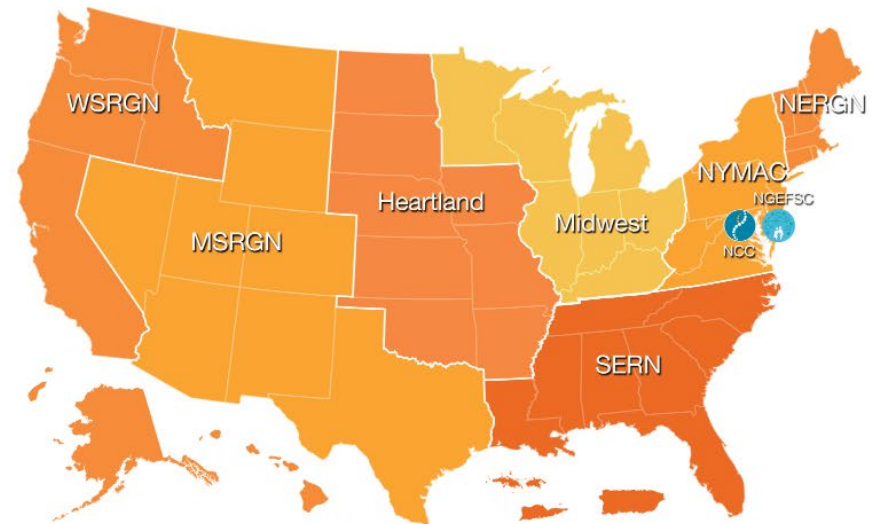
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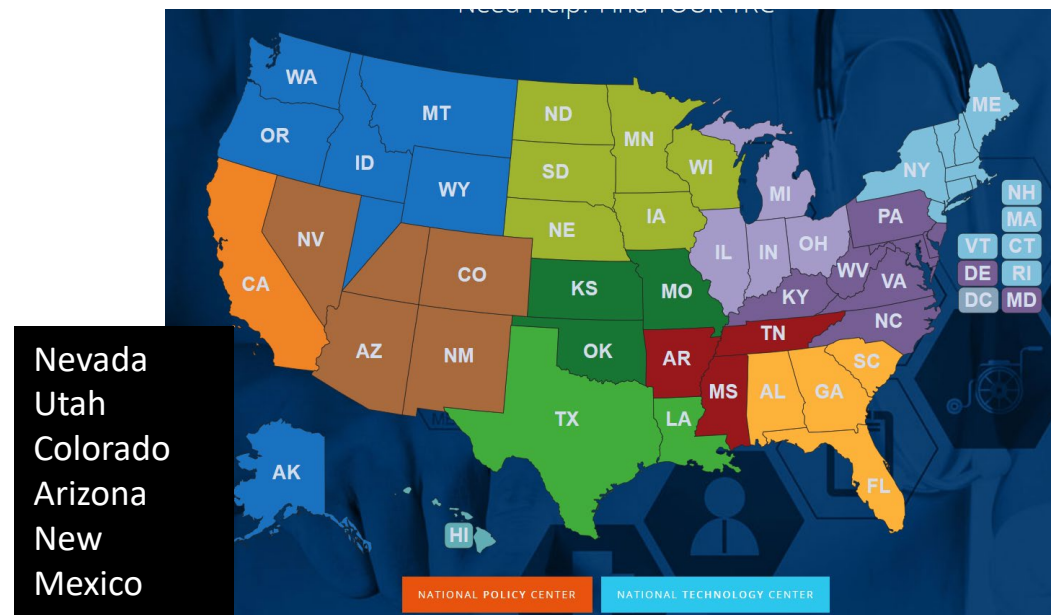
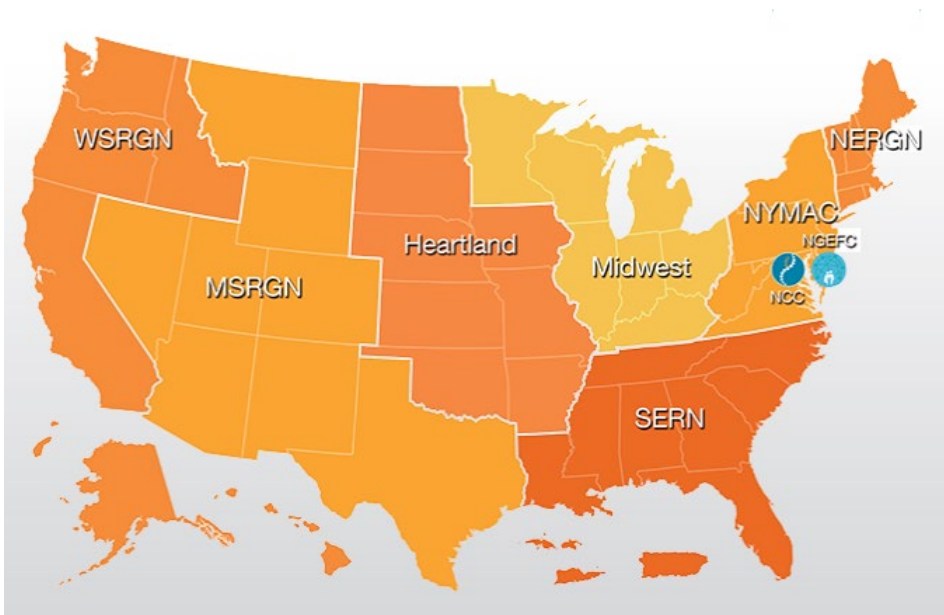

## Care Beyond Walls and Wires: In-home monitoring

Using remote monitoring tools, this program is designed to improve the quality of life for people with chronic health conditions, helping patients and families get the care they need without leaving home.

With daily access to information including blood pressure, weight and symptoms of illness, care teams and patients can co-manage treatment plans. It's also possible to detect changes in a patient's health status early on and intervene at the right time to avoid unnecessary travel and hospital care.

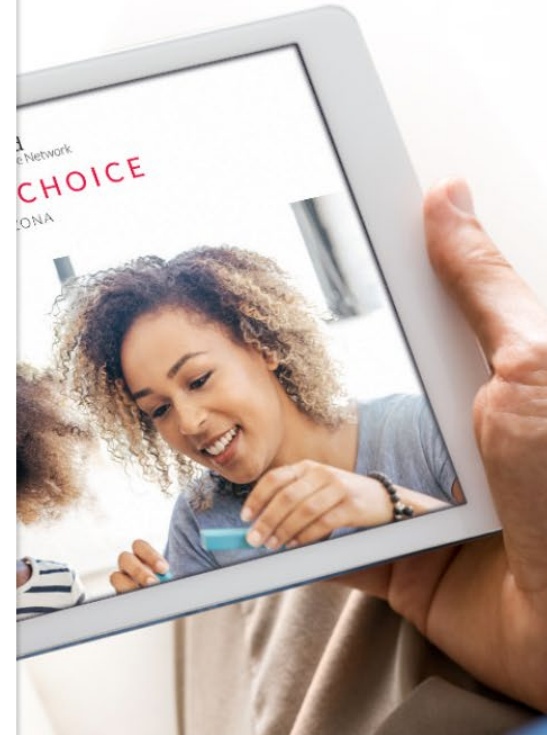

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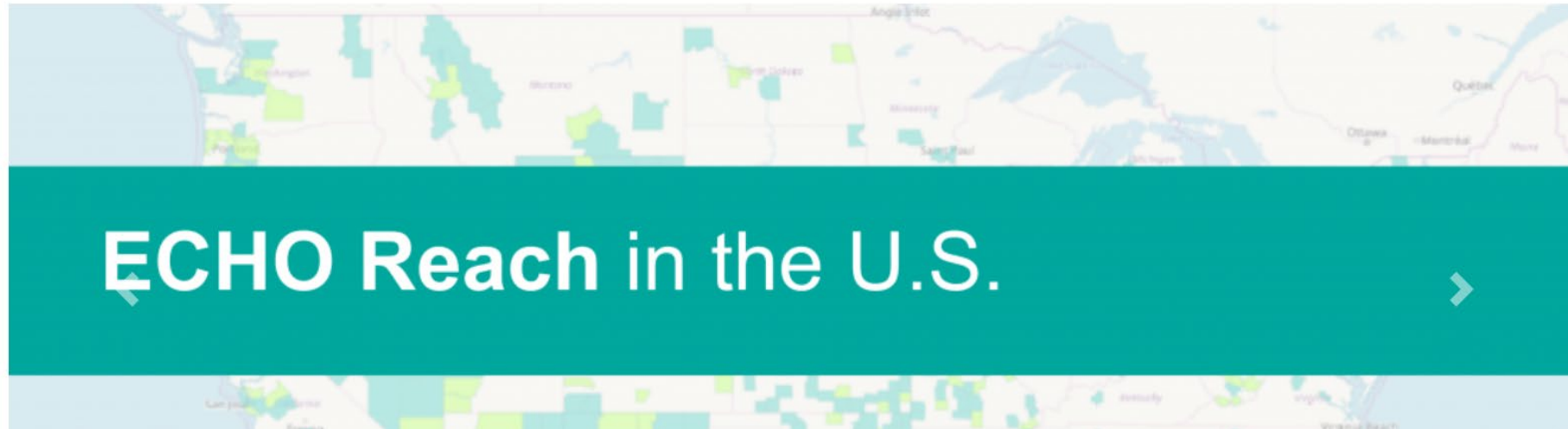
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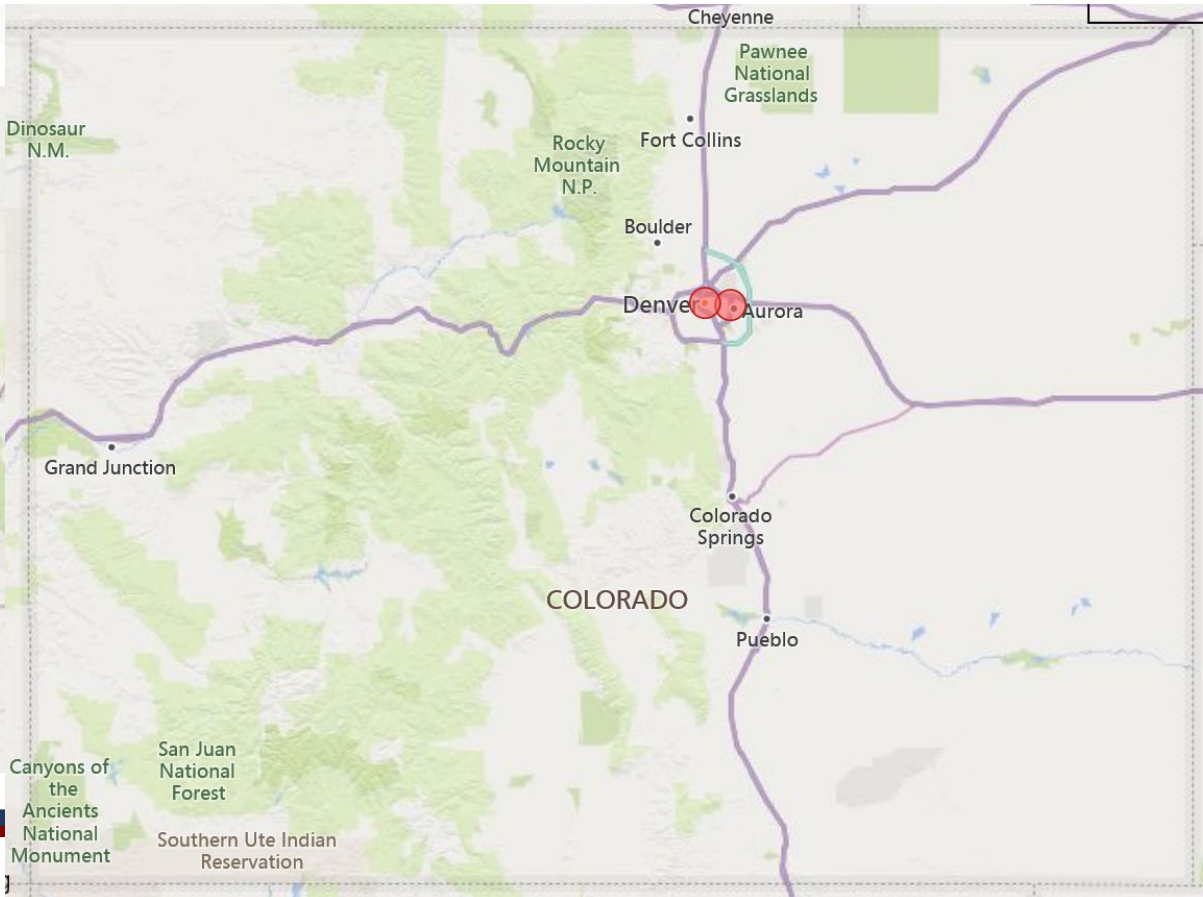
