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## Developing a Telemedicine Program

### Outcome Objectives

- 1.) Apply telehealth practice in clinical settings as applicable.
- 2.) Account for diagnostic accuracy of conventional practice compared to telehealth practice.
- 3.) Apply payment policies for reimbursement of telehealth services appropriately.
- 4.) Incorporate telehealth video conferencing etiquette into practice.
- 5.) Circumvent barriers to interprofessional communication using telehealth.
- 6.) Coordinate and improve care of patients with chronic diseases in rural settings.
- 7.) Decrease the time to gain access to medical specialists with telehealth capabilities.
