JUL 2020: One killed, one injured in Mt. Laurel, NJ

FEB 2020: One killed in Rancho Mirage, CA

NOV 2018: Three killed in Chicago, IL

JUL 2016: Two killed in Florida

JAN 2015: One killed in Boston, MA

DEC 2013: Three killed at a Reno, NV



"Betrayal of what is right by someone who holds legitimate authority in a high-stakes situation"


#### **TRANSGRESSION - LITZ, 2009**

"... perpetrating, failing to prevent, bearing witness to, or learning about acts that transgress deeply held moral beliefs and expectations."











