2. Sponsorship: identify the right sponsorship, be clear on what is specifically needed from each level of sponsors.
3. Reinforcement: start with positive reinforcement, move to negative reinforcement on the clearly defined behavior changes.

Jan Ground PT, MBA, has been leading clinicians and other healthcare personnel through change for more than twenty years. She led the virtual care work for the Colorado Permanente Medical Group and was the Innovation Hunter for the Colorado Region of Kaiser Permanente (KPCO). Most of her work supported innovation initiatives to enable people to get care anywhere and providers to provide care from anywhere. Areas of focus have included video visits, remote patient monitoring, e-visits, as well as the use of mobile apps and social media in care delivery. In all of these efforts, motivating providers to provide care differently was the most significant barrier to success. Jan has trained physicians and staff inside and outside of KP in Innovation, Meeting Management, and Leading People through Change.
