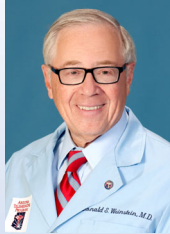


Recognize the benefits for your patients and practice

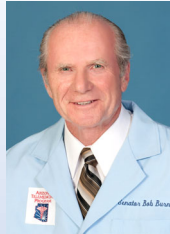
- Keep patients safe by reducing their need to travel for health care

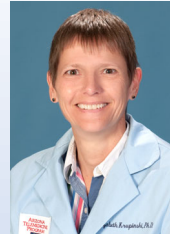

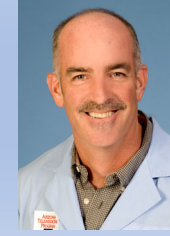
